Next Step Cards are a Solution-Focused, Goal Based Outcome resource which help practitioners to engage and empower children and young people, promoting psychological wellbeing. The Cards enable adults who support children and young people to have safe and structured conversations about emotional health and wellbeing and empower them to set and achieve self-defined goals. This is a tool that we feel will have multiple benefits for our children and Mrs Paton will start this important work alongside her busy office role this half term. Thank you Mrs Paton!
